- **Sunday 17 February** from 21h50 onwards. I counted 8-9 calls in the space of c. 10 minutes until I switched my phone off.
 - When I checked at 23h30, by using 1471, another call had been made at 22h28.
 - When I checked again at 2 am, also using 1471, another call had been made at 23h43
 - **BT told me yesterday morning that in fact, a total of 13 calls had been made – all from the same number**
- **Tuesday 19 February** when **7 calls** were made between 17h53 and 18h43

I would also add that I have lived at 3 Jefferson House, 11 Basil St, London SW3 1AX for 25 years i.e. since 1976. I have had the same telephone ie ██████████ throughout this period. And this number has always been ex-directory.
