Outstanding: Need to determine subscriber for land line telephone number
supplied by Reach Europe**

Mr Adams

Last week you told me the two calls made from a land line number on 19 February at 18h24 and 18h27 had been made from my home telephone number.

When I pointed out that this was totally impossible i.e. I have not been making anonymous phone calls to myself, you asked whether I subscribe to BT voice mail service (takes messages for calls to my home phone number). When I said yes, you replied that something must have gone wrong with this service and that it had been dialling my phone by mistake. You mentioned the name **Reach Europe** as the source of the calls.

I have phoned **BT** to clarify. These calls have absolutely nothing to do with them. They told me that **Reach Europe** is a telephone supplier. Hence, they added that the police needs to contact this supplier to get the subscriber for the telephone number they provided you with.

BT said they would be happy to explain this to you. Their number is 0800 0854 750.

Many thanks in anticipation of your pursuing this inquiry – (as well as sending confirmation of your findings – as detailed in the fax I sent you yesterday)
