I acknowledge receipt of your letters dated 27 January 2003 and 4 February 2003. (NB: Should be '6' Feb

Given the extreme vagueness of the accusation:

- Your letter of 27 January reports the accusation as follows: "The police have been informed by a Mr Andrew Ladsky that you verbally abused him in public over some sort of dispute revolving around your premises."
- While your correspondence of 4 February states: "... This revolves around an incident on the 25th January 2003."

In order for me to respond, please, provide me – **in writing** – with the following:

1. The time at which the incident is alleged to have taken place
2. Precisely where the incident is alleged to have taken place
3. As the accusation states that it was "in public" who is alleged to have been present
4. Precisely what I am alleged to have said
5. Precisely the context in which this is alleged to have been said. You state "over some sort of dispute revolving around your premises". Please, provide specific details.
