I am writing on behalf of Fiona Woolf to thank you for your letter of 28 February. Unfortunately this is not something the President is able to assist you with. The representative, regulatory and complaints handling functions of the Law Society have formally separated: the Law Society deals with representation matters, the Solicitors Regulation Authority (SRA) deals with regulation matters and the Legal Complaints Service (LCS) deals with complaints about solicitors. The SRA and LCS operate independently of the Law Society. As the matter you have raised concerns a complaint about a solicitor, I have passed your letter to the office of the CEO of the Legal Complaints Service.
