AMENDED BILL OF COSTS

Following my visit to West London County Court on Thursday afternoon 30 October 2008 to get confirmation that the 4 November 2008 Detailed Assessment hearing was due to take place as planned, I made another visit on Monday 3 November, at 14h30. The same court staff (who is evidently managing the file, as he dealt with me on my previous visits, getting up automatically as I arrive at the counter) - yet again confirmed to me that the hearing would take place as planned.

On Tuesday 4 November 2008, District Judge Nicholson informed me that the court had received a fax from you on 3 November 2008 at 11h07 (i.e. 3.5 hours before my visit to the court). He read out the fax in which you state that my 31 October 2008 fax to you was the first time you had been informed of the hearing. This is rather extraordinary considering that, on 31 October 2008, the court staff yet again reconfirmed that you had been informed. (I took delivery of a copy of your 3 November letter to the court on 4 November).

District Judge Nicholson then said that, any case, at 10h00, i.e. on 4 November 2008, he had written an order that the case be transferred to the Supreme Court Costs Office "*because it is a detailed assessment hearing*".

I delayed writing this letter, waiting for the order to arrive. However, at the date of writing, I have not received anything from West London County Court.

In light of this transfer, I am taking the opportunity to review my 26 August 2008 submissions.

1 My Bill of Costs (initially sent to you on 26 June 2008 as my 'Statement of Costs')

You have stated in your 11 August 2008 Points of Dispute that it is not in the correct format.

Having done more desk research, it may be that I have not split 'Part 3 – Correspondence' into sub-headings. However, I cannot restructure it as you have used my numbering for your Points of Dispute.

In the attached, Bill of Costs, dated 11 November 2008¹, I have:

1. Added a column 'Time total' to combine 'Loss of pay' and 'Personal time'
2. Added a summary to each of the four parts, and combined these at the end of the bill.

3. Expanded the narrative for the items
4. In relation to item #12, '4 April 2007 Application for contesting jurisdiction', I have removed the following hours of annual leave: 4.5 hours on Monday 2 April 2008, 3.5 hours on Tuesday 3 April 2008 and 3.5 hours on Thursday 5 April 2008, or a total of 11.5 hours as, while the loss is also attributable to your client, it was not my primary reason for taking the time off.

Furthermore, because of the similarity in the deadline for the Application to contest jurisdiction (4 April 2007) and the Skeleton argument (3 May 2007), by error, I included 1.5 hours to the Skeleton argument instead of attributing it to the Application.

Hence:

- Loss of pay for Application to contest jurisdiction is 6 hours (instead of 19.5 hours) = £217.56 (instead of £707.07)
- Loss of pay for the Skeleton argument is 21.5 hours (instead of 20 hours) = £779.59 (instead of £725.20).

Attached is 'Schedule – Timesheets'² of all my timesheets detailing the activity for each set of hours - followed by a summary for each activity.

Impact on interest:

- Application to contest jurisdiction: £21.56 (instead of £70.08)
- Skeleton argument: £72.24 (instead of £67.20)

Overall, it reduces my Bill of costs from £7,756.03 to £7,277.43 (and the interest from £218.37 to £174.89)

For ease of identification, all the amendments on my Bill of Costs are in bold, red font.

2 My 26 August 2008 reply to your Points of Dispute

As a result of going to West London County Court and pointing out that the 12 September 2008 Notice of hearing identifies me as the Defendant instead of the Claimant, it was pointed out to me that, in the case of the Detailed Assessment proceedings, I am still regarded as the Defendant.

In light of this, I am in the process of amending my 26 August 2008 reply accordingly and will subsequently send you the amended version.

I will also resubmit my bundle at the appropriate time.
