I acknowledge receipt of your 'General Form of Judgment or Order' dated 1 July 2004 to which was attached the 'Draft Consent Order' sent to you by CKFT. The Consent Order does not have the stamp of the Court on it. I do not know whether there should be one to endorse its validity

As you can see from the enclosed, in its 'Notice of Transfer of Proceedings', dated 9 June 2004<sup>1</sup>, West London County Court stated:
